The first part of the question is regarding ethnicity. Ethnicity is based on the following categorization:

Hispanic or Latino: A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

Hispanic/Latino is considered ethnicity, **not** a race.

Not Hispanic or Latino: A person not from the above cultures or origins.

The second part of the question asks the race(s) of the student or staff. Respondents are allowed to choose more than one race. Race is based on the following five categorizations:

American Indian or Alaska Native: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America and who maintains tribal affiliation or community attachment.

Asian: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent, including for example, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, and Vietnam.

Black or African American: A person having origins in any black racial groups of Africa.

Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.

White: A person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East, or North Africa.

Please note that the federal guidelines require that the race and ethnicity for all respondents must be collected, and you are not allowed to include "Unknown" or "Decline to State" in federal reports.
